## DEMONSTRATOR

A demonstrator can be a student who has active student status in any MA Programme of the Faculty. One can win the title by application. The mandate is for 2 semesters (10 months). The title is awarded by the Dean of the Faculty based on the submitted proposals and the recommendation given by the Director of the Institute.

In addition to the Director of the Institute, the student is commented on by the Tutor who supports the professional work of the demonstrator (he/she/they writes the recommendation). The Tutor is responsible for ensuring that the demonstrator can perform work regularly. The specific tasks of the demonstrator are determined by the Tutor and the Director of the Institute.

The demonstrator is entitled to:

- join research activities belonging to the Institute
- take part in professional events
- if the Institute regularly does not perform the substantive indicate this fact to the Student Union

Working as a demonstrator does not automatically entail a stipend. Payment for these services will be made available in the spring semester by application to the teaching assistants' scholarship announced by the PPK Student Union.
