At the conference, students **can present their papers** documenting their research in the form of a **10-minute oral presentation**. To apply, please send a short summary of your paper to¹. If the authors are enrolled in an English-language course, the paper can also be submitted in English.

The jury of the in-person house competition, held in the Izabella Street building of ELTE, will recommend the deserving entries for the **36th National Scientific Student Conference on Pedagogy, Psychology, Andragogy and Library Science Section**, to be held in 2023, based on the oral presentation.

More information:

- Both the conference and the house competition are open to *papers* resulting from student research. An important criterion is that the paper must contain independent and new research results.
- When preparing for the institutional SSA conference, it is worth bearing in mind the aspects of the section specification for the national SSA paper to be submitted later. It should be no more than 3 pages in length (including figures, tables and references), scientific and professional in style, and in accordance with the formal requirements of scientific publications (e.g. APA citation style).
