Demonstrator can be a student who has active student status in any BA/MA Programme of the Faculty. During evaluation of the applications, priority is given to students of the English language Psychology BA & MA students.

The title can be won by application. The mandate is for 2 semesters (10 months). The title is awarded by the Dean of the Faculty, based on the submitted proposals and the recommendation given by the Head of the Institute.

In addition to the Head of the Institute, the student is commented on by the Tutor who supports the professional work of the demonstrator (he/she/they writes the recommendation). The Tutor is responsible for ensuring that the demonstrator can perform work on a regular basis. The specific tasks of the demonstrator are determined by the Tutor and the Head of the Institute.

The demonstrator is entitled to:

- join to research activities belonging to the Institute
- take part in professional events
- if the institute regularly does not perform the substantive indicate this fact to the Student Union
