



**ELTE PPK, DEPARTMENT OF PERSONALITY AND HEALTH PSYCHOLOGY AND
DEPARTMENT OF CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY AND ADDICTION IS LAUNCHING
A COMPETITION FOR THE POSITION OF DEMONSTRATOR FOR
THE 2024/25 ACADEMIC YEAR**

A demonstrator is a full-time, active status student of ELTE-PPK

- interested in the disciplines taught and researched by the two Departments
- has two semesters with at least 4.00 mean grade
- and undertakes the demonstrator's tasks, working up to 10 hours a week.

The demonstrator's mandate can be obtained by appointment; the assignment is for two semesters (10 months).

The Dean of ELTE PPK awards the title of the demonstrator based on the submitted applications and the support from the Heads of the Departments. In addition to the heads of the departments, the student is reviewed by the instructor assisting the demonstrator's professional work (he writes the teacher's recommendation).

The heads of the two departments determine the specific tasks of the demonstrator and the instructor assisting the demonstrator's professional work. The demonstrator must report on his work every six months. In the spring semester, the demonstrator may apply for a professional scholarship to the Student Government, accompanied by the recommendation of the head of the research team/responsible instructor/head of department.

The Dean of ELTE PPK awards the title of the demonstrator based on the proposals submitted and the recommendation from the Head of the Institute.

The deadline for the evaluation is **4 October 2024**.

The general tasks of the demonstrator are:

- participation in the scientific research work of the institute/department (active scientific student activity);
- participation in the teaching-related work;
- involvement in various tasks of teaching and research organization (e.g. organizing practices, organizing conferences, preparing proposals, organizing professional events, etc.);
- participation in the administrative tasks of the institute/research group;
- contributing to the relations between the Departments and the students and the work of the scientific student group;
- report to the Departments at specified intervals (every six months) on its work.

The demonstrator may participate in the meetings of the departments, participate in research work carried out by the faculty of the department and participate in professional programmes.

The application must include:

1. Application form¹ (<https://ppk.elte.hu/hallgatoi-palyazatok/demonstrator>)
2. Motivation letter
3. CV
4. The summary pages of the previous semesters from Neptun.
5. Teachers' recommendation.

The heads of both departments evaluate the application only with the signed recommendation of at least one of the instructors. The instructors can also send the recommendation letter from their official email addresses.

Deadline for submission of the application: **20 September 2024.**
